	Move furniture, tools, art, or décor out of the entry path.
	Clear driveways and access points; remove personal and trade vehicles.
	Whenever possible, BAGM will enter through the garage or front door - please allow our trucks to park close
	to these areas.
	Avoid driveway construction immediately before or during installation.
	Ensure other trades are not working in access areas while materials are being carried in.
	For non-ground-level installations, discuss access, seams, or special equipment needs with your project
	manager in advance.

To prot	ect everyone's safety and ensure efficient installation:
Î 🗆	Keep pets and children away from all work zones.
	Have other trades clear the area until our work is complete.
	Clear off all support surfaces (cabinets, existing counters, etc.).
	Completely empty sink cabinet, cooktop, and corner cabinets.
_	Other cabinets can remain full, but expect minimal dust or debris.
	Remove top drawers for access.
	Disconnect all plumbing , electrical , and gas connections prior to installation. Remove any cabinetry sitting on existing countertops.
	Discuss appliance removal with your template technician or project manager — some items may need to be
Ш	taken out temporarily.

~	Have All Cut-Out Items On Site
Please	ensure all cut-out items are on-site and ready for review, including:
	Sinks, faucets, cooktops, grommets, pop-up outlets, kegerator taps, and similar fixtures.
	Our technicians will mount undermount sinks and test-fit most other cut-out items to ensure proper fit.
	After Installation
	Allow 24 hours before using the installed area or having other trades work nearby. This ensures all adhesives
_	and caulks have been cured properly and prevents dust from affecting the finish.
	Our team will perform a broom-swept clean-up , but some additional cleaning may be needed.
	Minor wall scuffs may occur during installation. BAGM technicians take care to protect cabinetry and will prioritize avoiding cabinet damage. Please share any special concerns with your project manager or template
	technician.
	Cover your countertops if other trades are working afterward – our surfaces are durable but not designed to
	serve as workbenches.
	A project manager will review your installation the following morning using technician notes and photos.
	You'll be contacted by noon the next day if any issues are identified.
